SIGNIFICANCE	436 Rainbow Road is one of the finest Greek Revival era dwellings in the Town. The house retains much of its original detail and is beautifully maintained. Note the simplicity of the form and materials, accented with elegant details such as the gable windows and entry with side lights. Compare with other Greek Revival dwellings down the street at 312, 362, and 371 Rainbow Road. This house was built by Benomi Case in 1834. It was later inherited by his son, Otis. Both were farmers. With Otis Case's death in 1870, the property was sold to Manley Snow and remained in the Snow family for nearly 100 years.
