The house is a noteworthy example of the shingle style, frequently used in late 19th and early 20th Century resort homes for the wealthy, but relatively rare in South Carolina. The Phelps estate, which served as the location for the first meetings of the Garden Club of South Carolina, contains a formal landscaped garden. The elegant home and landscaped grounds are characteristic of many such estates owned by the wealthy in pre-income tax America.

<u>Architectural</u>: The Phelps house is an example of the shingle style, identified by the shingled facade and exterior horizontal emphasis. One of the most innovative features of shingle style houses is the free-flowing, asymmetrical floorplan. Originally used in New England in the 1880s for medium-sized private houses, the shingle style is relatively uncommon in South Carolina.

Landscape Architecture: Original owner of the house, Mrs. Sheffield Phelps, landscaped the grounds and formal gardens containing camellias, azaleas, hollies, and English boxwood. Camellias were of particular interest to the owner who imported rare varieties from Japan and developed a new variety on the estate, the Rose Hill Red.

In addition to an interest in the practical aspects of landscaping her own garden, Mrs. Phelps collected books on botany and horticulture. The collection, donated to the South Caroliniana Library in 1959, contains valuable 18th and 19th Century books. Works include 49 volumes of The Botanical Magazine, published in London 1787-1820, and a 1721 edition of Mark Catesby's Natural History of Carolina, Florida, and the Bahama Islands.

The Phelps house was the location for the first meetings of the Garden Club of South Carolina, organized in 1930 by Mrs. Phelps, who served as honorary life president. Patterned after the Garden Club of America, the statewide group promotes gardening, landscaping, and conservation. At present there are approximately 13,000 members in the Garden Club of South Carolina.

<u>Social Humanitarian</u>: In the early 1900s Aiken was a popular resort for wealthy northerners. Attracted by the mild climate and riding facilities, Winter Colony residents participated in fox hunts, polo, steeple chases, and races. Typical of the cosmopolitan population which included wealthy publishers, railroad magnates, and copper industry tycoons, the Phelps
