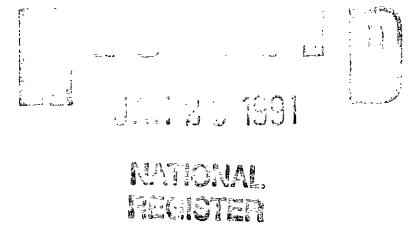

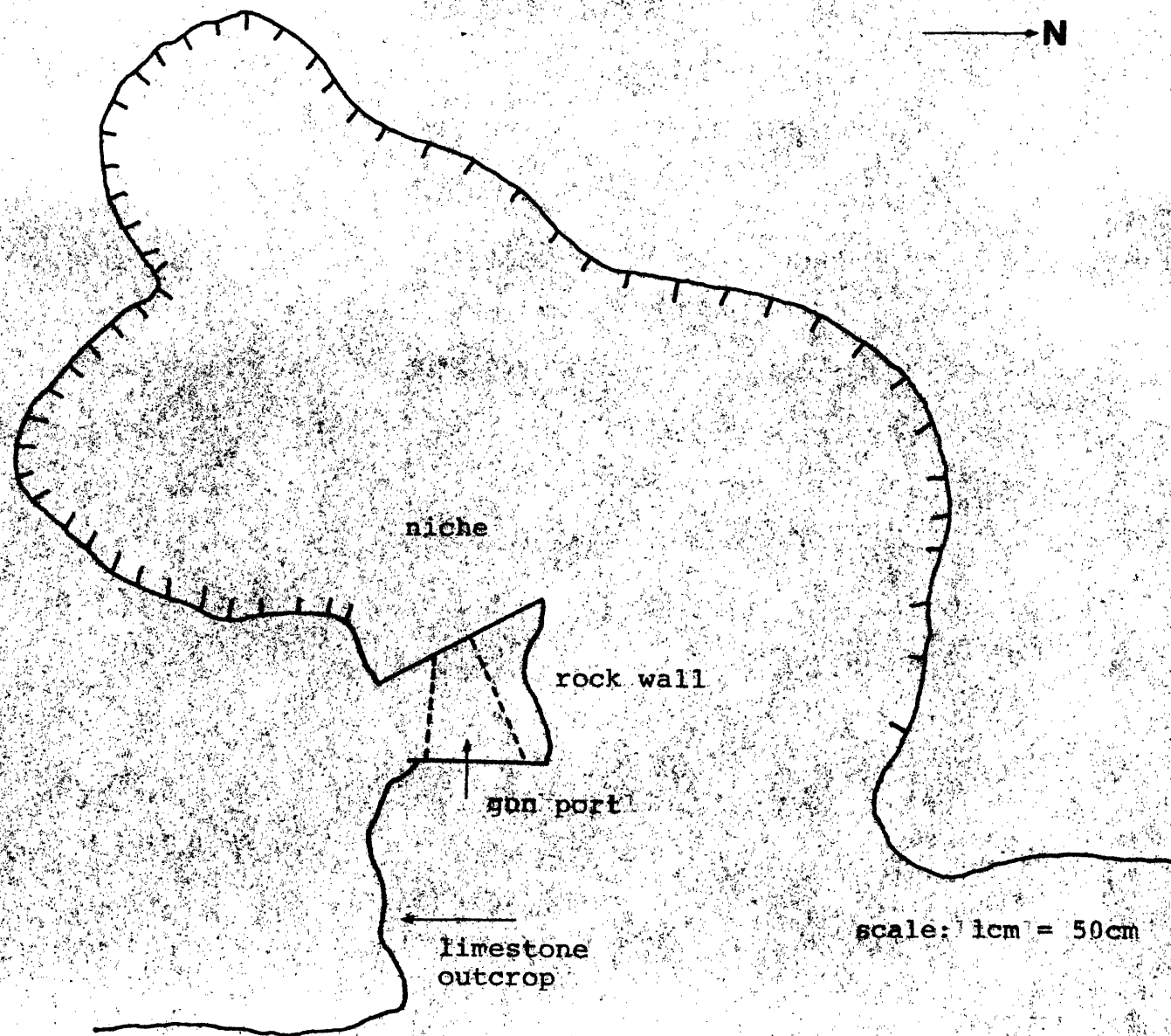

The Inarajan Pillbox is built into a niche in the raised limestone outcrop on the southern side of Inarajan Bay, 11.0m south of a natural arch in the outcrop. Coral rocks have been cemented together to form a wall approximately 1.80m long, 1.0m wide, and 2.0m high. The structure is in good condition.

The wall extends only partially across the opening of the niche. It is not clear whether the logs of trees enclosed the opening and/or formed a roof. The walls of the niche range from 1.75m to 2.50m high. The niche is about 7.0m long and 4.50m wide. A cement gun port is located in the piled rock wall. The opening of the wide side of the embrasure measures .72m by .25m. The bottom of the gun port is .74m above the floor of the niche. Presently vegetation obscures a view of the bay from the gun port.
