DESCRIPTION

The Gypsy Camp Historic District, located on the Illinois River, is made up of eight structures and associated landscape features. Four of the buildings are cabins or sleeping quarters for campers, one is the dining and recreation hall, two are private residences for people associated with the camp and the last was a private residence which was converted for storage use. In the middle of the cluster of buildings is a rock wall and rock arbor that together create a nice sitting area. The camp buildings are of frame construction and have either pine slats or board and batten as an exterior wall material. All of the sleeping quarters are "split level," with the upper level being covered by a low-pitched gable roof and the lower level by a shed roof.

Established in 1921 as a camp for girls, the Gypsy Camp survives as the only collection of buildings in Benton County, and probably in the state, which were constructed for this purpose. The relatively mild summers of Northwest Arkansas, as well as the location of many resort towns, made the area a popular vacation spot for people from around the country. Girls from the ages of seven to seventeen came to Gypsy Camp, where activities centered around the creative: dance, arts, crafts. Sports such as swimming and archery were of course included. The Gypsy appellation comes from the theme of the camp, and girls brought "gypsy" costumes and jewelry to wear at the endof-camp "coronation." The girls' camp was operated until 1978 and the present owner, grandson of the original owner, now rents the camp out for church activities and family reunions.
