Describe the present and original (if known) physical appearance

This large residential district consists of approximately 750 structures, most of which were built between 1850 and 1930. The district features architectural styles from every period of its growth including Greek Revival, Queen Anne, Colonial Revival, Spanish Mission, Bungalow, Arts and Crafts and Tudor. The houses in the northern half of the district tend to be closely-spaced, modest cottages while the majority in the southern end tend to be large homes set well back from the street on spacious lots. Many of the larger homes were designed by noted local architects of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. In addition to houses, the district also includes several very fine examples of church architecture and one excellent, early twentieth century, public high school.

The entire area is laid out on a block grid system with long, wide, parallel streets running north and south intersected by a series of short, narrow streets running east and west. The majority of the larger houses are located on the wider, north-south streets, and the more modest homes tend to be concentrated on the narrow, intersecting streets. A unifying feature of the district is the consistent use of hexagonal, Schillinger, concrete sidewalk pavers used throughout the neighborhood.

The current condition of the buildings in the district varies from poor to excellent with the majority in the latter category. Those buildings which are in poor condition are primarily concentrated in a small area in the extreme northern end of the district. Some modest commercial enterprises have sprung up in recent years in the northern neighborhood. The remainder of the district, however, is very well preserved and completely residential.

Statement of Significance (in one paragraph)

Architecture: Criterion C

The Garden District is primarily significant for its collection of fine 19th and early 20th century domestic structures, many of which represent the best works of noted local architects (and one nationally noted architect--Ralph Adams Cram), including Frank Lockwood, Weatherly Carter, B. B. Smith, Edward Okel and Carl Cooper. The district is also significant for its good and representative examples of middle and working class dwellings, as well as for a fine collection of late 19th and early 20th century churches and one excellent early 20th century high school. Styles represented in the district include: Queen Anne, Colonial Revival, Spanish and Tudor Revivals, Greek Revival, Arts and Crafts, Bungalow, Victorian Cottages and vernacular houses of the period.

Urban Planning & Development: Criteria A & C:

The district is a representative example of a Southern suburban neighborhood which developed over a 40-year time span (1890-1930) and reflects the impact that the street-car and automobile had on the process of suburbanization in the South. The distribution of working, middle and upper class houses illustrates the separate developments that took place within the district for different socioeconomic groups.

Commerce: Criterion B:

The district is associated with many of the business leaders of Montgomery who made their homes in the late 1890s well into the mid-20th century. Among the more significant citizens were: nationally known building contractor Algenon Blair (1873-1952); industrialist Arthur Pelzer (1865-1951); real estate developers Hartwell Douglass (1865-1934) and Mose Stuart (1878-1960); nationally known cotton broker Emil Weil and prominent banker Lewis B. Farley. Other locally significant professional men who made their homes in the district are: Dr. Charles A. Thigpen (1865-1958), a prominent physician; and Jack Thorington, a local lawyer.
