PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: The Cheever Farmhouse is a small 1½ story 3 bay red clapboarded dwelling set on a knoll with a southern exposure. The most prominent features of its principal facade are a pair of symmetrically placed shed dormers, each with a single window, and an unembellished center entry. A one story rear section, "added many years ago" according to the current owner, forms an unusual saltbox configuration which mitigates the house's otherwise Greek Revival aspect.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: This house makes a contribution to Harrisville's inventory of historic buildings through its survival as a well-maintained example of a mid-19th century farmhouse. It achieves additional importance through its highly visible location in the part of town which was originally Nelson. (Its period, use and setting are comparable to that of (IP5, the Jabez Townsend House in Eastview). It is architecturally unusual because of its "saltbox" addition. The Cheever Farmhouse satisfies Criteria A of the National Register of Historic Places.


