### DESCRIPTION

ARCHITECTURAL STYLE Vernacular Victorian                      DATE c.1888  
FORM                      2 story upright-and-wing, with 3-bay front gable and side bay entrance  
MATERIALS                brick on stone foundation, latter cement-covered  
FENESTRATION            1/1 d.h.s., aluminum; flush stone hoods with incised decoration  
FEATURES                 flat board frieze below cornice  
ALTERATIONS            lacks main entrance porch; enclosed porch in re-entrant angle;  
possibly sandblasted  
SITE                        medium-sized, flat lot in area of frame houses

**ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE** See statement for 14W1429. The houses should be considered as a pair, rather than as individuals. This is particularly true for 14W1421, which has experienced more alteration than its neighbor.

This house differs from 1429 W. 14th in its brick color, which in this case is a lighter pink.

**HISTORICAL DATA**

Joachim Plambeck, German immigrant and woodworker, was first occupant of this house, which was built about 1888.

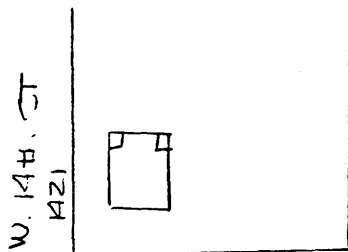
