DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Columbia County Courthouse, designed by W. W. Hall and built in 1905 is an example of Second Renaissance Revival. The structure, rectangular in plan and domed, is composed of blond brick with stone detailing. The two storeys, separated by an agee cornice, are articulated differently at each level. Windows at the first level have stone lintels separating their transoms from the window proper. The sills are stone and the transoms are topped by stone flat arches and pronounced key stones. On the second level, masonry pilasters with Corinthian capitals separate windows which are topped by corniced stone lintels. A modillioned and denticulated cornice articulates the top of the building. The foundation is of rusticated stone. Each elevation is broken into three bays.

The north and south elevations are identical with the middle bay inset. The entrances on these elevations are interior porches the openings of which are framed in a semi-circular stone arch springing from a masonry pier which is set into full entablature composed of Corinthian capitals pilasters supporting a modillioned and denticulated cornice. Above the entrance, on the second level, is a gallery with Corinthian capitals and decorative iron railing.

On the east elevation, a two storey, pedimented portico forms the main entrance to the building. The first level of the portico is a masonry rectangle opened by three Roman arches on the east side and by one on the north and one on the south. The imposts are of stone and the arches are stone with pronounced keystones. On the second level, a Corinthian colonnade supports a pediment containing an acanthus frieze.

The entrance, center, bay of the west elevation projects slightly. It also is two storied and has a pediment and acanthus frieze. At its first level is an interior porch like that on the north and south elevations. Above are Corinthian pilasters between windows bays.

There have been few alterations to the exterior of the structure. Wooden windows have been replaced with metal windows and the north and south entrances have been cemented.

The interior, however, is much altered. Originally, there was a cross-shaped hall running between the four entrances. The north to south axis is now partitioned into office space. Some interior surfaces have been paneled. The courtroom on the second floor was originally two storeys high with a gallery around the rotunda walls. However, a third floor was built above the courtroom and uses space in the rotunda.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The three-storey Columbia County Courthouse, designed by W. W. Hall, was built in 1905. Today, its exterior remains a classic example of Second Renaissance Revival architecture. The massive, rectangular structure is composed of blond brick with stone detailing. Only two stories are apparent through observation of the exterior. These floors are separated by an agee cornice. The rotunda which centers the building and which once housed a tall courtroom, has been divided to form two floors, one of which forms the building's third floor.

All detailing on the building reflects the revival of interest in the Classic and Renaissance motif, which characterized much of America's and Arkansas' public building in the early twentieth-century. Corinthian columns, arcades, pediments, keystone lintels and the rotunda are a few of the Neo-Classic Revival features found on the structure. In keeping with Renaissance, the exterior treatment of each floor is articulated in differing patterns. The north and south elevations of the structure are identical and the entrances to each of these elevations have been concreted over as the hallways leading from these entrances have been transformed into office and storage space. The main entrance, a Roman three-bay arcade surmounted by a second floor, colonnaded portico, is located on the east elevation.

The basic fabric of the interior remains intact. However, its original appearance is much altered. The interior has been partitioned into modern office space and many of the original walls have been paneled. The original wooden stairway remains and the east-west entrance-hallway presents reasonable if somewhat worn, reminders of its original appearance. The two-storey courtroom, located in the rotunda, has been divided into two floors and the upper floor serves as a second courtroom in the building.

Centering a square around which is built the Magnolia business district, the Columbia County courthouse is the third courthouse to occupy the site. Columbia County was formed in 1852 and became the fifty-fifth of Arkansas' seventy-five counties. Almost immediately after the county was organized, a temporary log courthouse was built on the south side of Magnolia's public square. Construction began on a permanent courthouse in 1856. In 1903, a two-mill tax levy mas made for the construction of the present courthouse building and the contract was made for the lowest bid of \$58, 631.21 in 1905. Initially, Columbia County was one of Arkansas' leaders in cotton production. However, in recent years the oil and timber industries have formed the backbone of the local economy.

Another, if somewhat more abstract, area of significance belonging to the building is that it symbolizes the historic role county government has played in

Columbia County. County government has been and is the closest and most personal contact between the people of Columbia County and representative democracy. The administrative arm of county government is conducted by a body of officials elected in a county-wide ballot. The fiscal and minor judicial work of the county is handled by the Quorum Court, whose members are elected by voters grouped in townships. Duties of the county government are varied and range from the maintenance and improvement of highways to the issuing of marriage licenses and the recording of deeds. The county even serves, to some extent, as the basic administrative and judicial unit of state government. The state welfare and auditorial departments and chancery and juvenile courts all operate at the county level.

In Arkansas, as a rule, the county courthouse building is one of the most impressive public buildings in the county. This is certainly the case for the Columbia County Courthouse in Magnolia. The emphasis upon the large size and impressive detailing found on the courthouse reflects the importance which the citizens of the county have placed upon local government, for county government administers to basic local needs of the people, and by doing so has helped to determine the pattern which history has followed in Columbia County.


