NAME Kremer House

LOCATION Corner of 3rd Street and Main, outlet #6, E 1/2 parcel.

OWNER Gladys Lee

ADDRESS Lesterville, South Dakota 57040

DESCRIPTION The 1904 Kremer House is a one story structure with a truncated hip roof. It is faced with clapboard siding and has a mortar veneer foundation. The front facade features a hip roof dormer with two double hung windows and an open porch with turned columns, lower rail balusters and a lattice work crawl space. The central entrance is a six panel door with a center stained glass window. The door is flanked on the left by a large light window with stained glass overhead and on the right by a double hung window with diamond patterned upper light. The south facade features an enclosed porch with a hip roof dormer. All windows on the north and south sides are double hung with simple frames.

STYLE Vernacular/Hip Cottage

DATE 1904

SIGNIFICANCE The 1904 Kremer House is significant architecturally because it is a good example of a vernacular residential style common to the resource area and to the state generally.

BOUNDARIES The nominated property is located 400 feet north of the road leading from Lesterville to U.S. Highway 81 on the northwest corner of the curve on the road leading north of Lesterville.
