


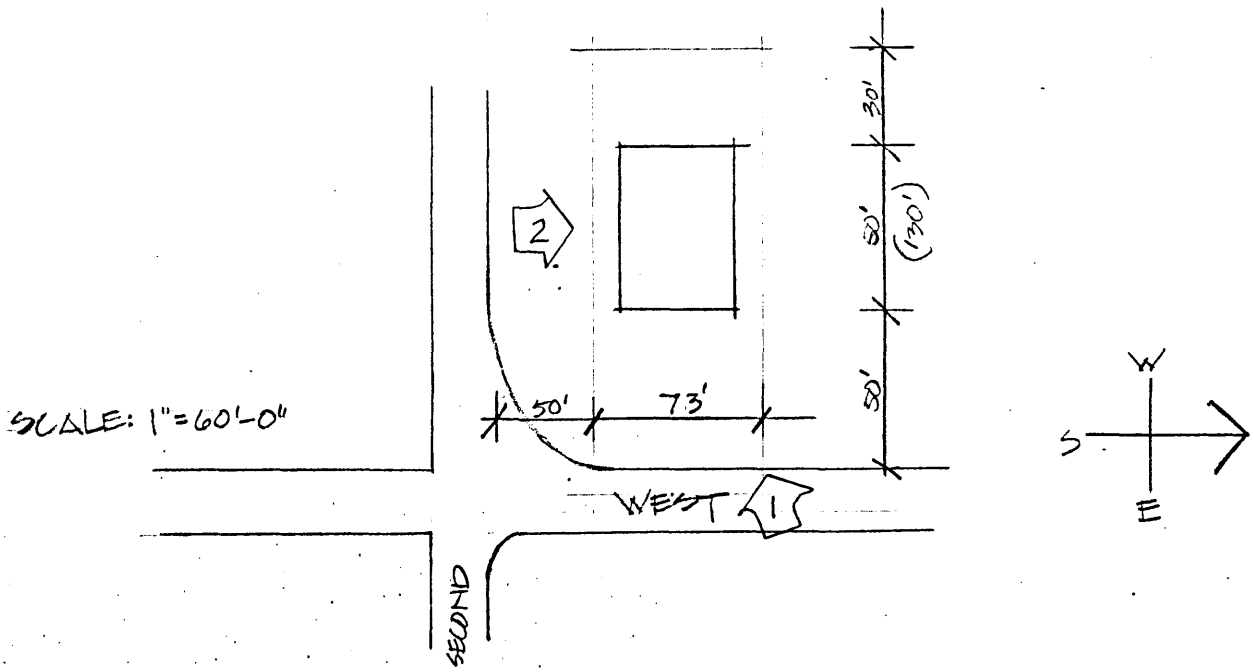

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage .37

Beginning at a point 50 feet north of the intersection of West and Second Streets; then north along the west right of way of West Street 73 feet to a point; then west 130 feet to a point; then south 73 feet to a point; then east 130 feet to the point of beginning.

The boundary contains all of the domestic space associated with the house and one contributing building.
