STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

building, as seen on either side of this structure. In terms of commerce, this building is significant for having been built to house the pharmacy of Dr. J.B. Jackson, a local physician. This pharmacy, a typical commercial enterprise in a small-town downtown, has been one of the most stable businesses on the square during the early to mid 20th century, having remained in business continuously since the 1920's with only a change in name.
