BOYDVILLE, shown above, is one of the most attractive and historic homes of Martinsville. The house was built by Gen. Elisha Boyd who purchased the land from the estate of Adam Stephen. General Boyd moved here in August 1812. At his death in 1844 the property fell to his daughter Mary, wife of Charles James Felt.
