VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A, a point 75 ft S of the stone house and between the lane and the rock fence, thence parallel to east wall of house, N 150 ft to B, thence at right angles, E 125 ft to C, S 150 ft to D, and W 125 ft to the beginning containing the stone house and rock cellar - about 1/2 acre.
