#### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Marysville post office is located two blocks east of the commercial center of the town, and is surrounded by several 19th century buildings. Marysville and Yuba County have no locally designated historic districts, and the property is not within a designated National Register district.

The post office is in excellent structural condition and is being well maintained.

Extensive additions were made in 1978-1981, though the original facade and south elevations were unaffected. The lobby was re-modeled during the same period. The remodeling extensively damaged the historic integrity of the interior. The original service windows were removed and replaced with a service counter, and the original lobby lights were replaced with 'florescent' fixtures. The exterior additions were more sensitive to the original style of the building. The new concrete walls are faced with brick matching the color and texture of the original, and casts of the terracotta ornament over the original windows were placed on the new walls.

The original building is an early example of the Starved Classical style. The facade is rigidly symmetrical, about an axis centered in the front entrance, and is divided into three parts. The central portion containing the front entrance is recessed about two feet from the wings on either side. A large terracotta relief is placed over the door and depicts an eagle perched on a stylized Corinthian capital. The front entrance is flanked by two windows on each side, each of which has a geometric terracotta moulding topped by a mexagonal terracotta plaque. The plaques, from north to south, depect three airplanes, a sailing ship, a steam ship and a locomotive. All of the sculpture is rendered in the conservative, art-deco inspired abstraction characteristic of the OSA. A window is placed in each of the projecting wings and is topped with an hexagonal plaque containing an eagle. The cornice is marked with a terracotta belt course, moulded with a triangular motif. The top portion of the belt course contains large, stylized "dentils" reminiscent of the dentil mouldings of Greek and Roman Architecture.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Though the building has been the victim of recent additions and alterations, the structure retains significant integrity of location, design, setting, association and feeling. It is an excellent example of the early Starved Classical style and contains notable examples of craftsmanship, particularly in its brickwork. In addition, the building has considerable local importance as the first federal building in Marysville. The decorative terracotta panels appear to have been designed in the office of the Supervising Architect and are craftsmanly executed in a style of the design output of the office in the early thirties.


