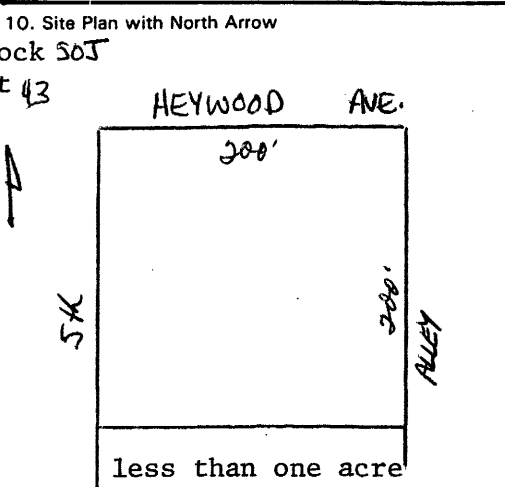

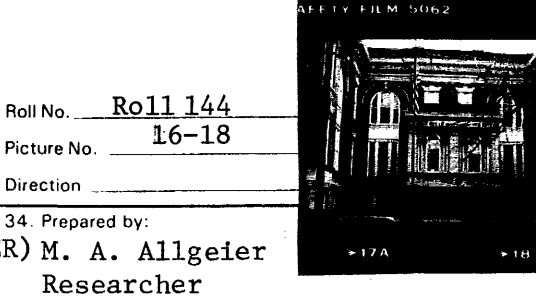
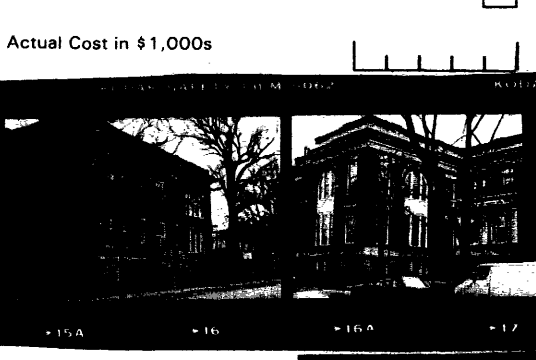

18. Description
 Heywood Elementary School is a two-story brick structure on a raised basement. The main block of the building is U-shaped with flanking wings added in 1926 in similar style of the original 1903 building. The central recessed bay contains a one-story projecting stone entry. Two Palladian windows face the street with the entrance on the east side. Stone pilasters separate the windows and carry an archi-

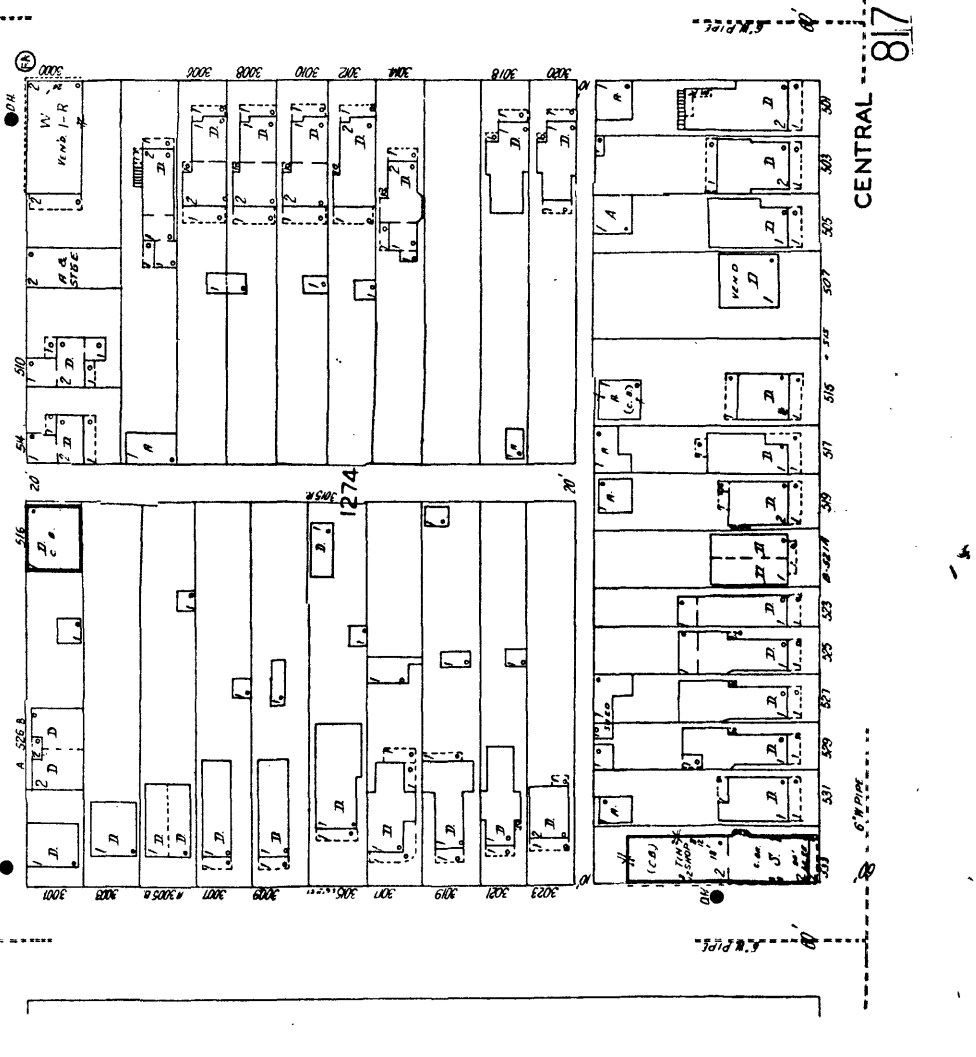
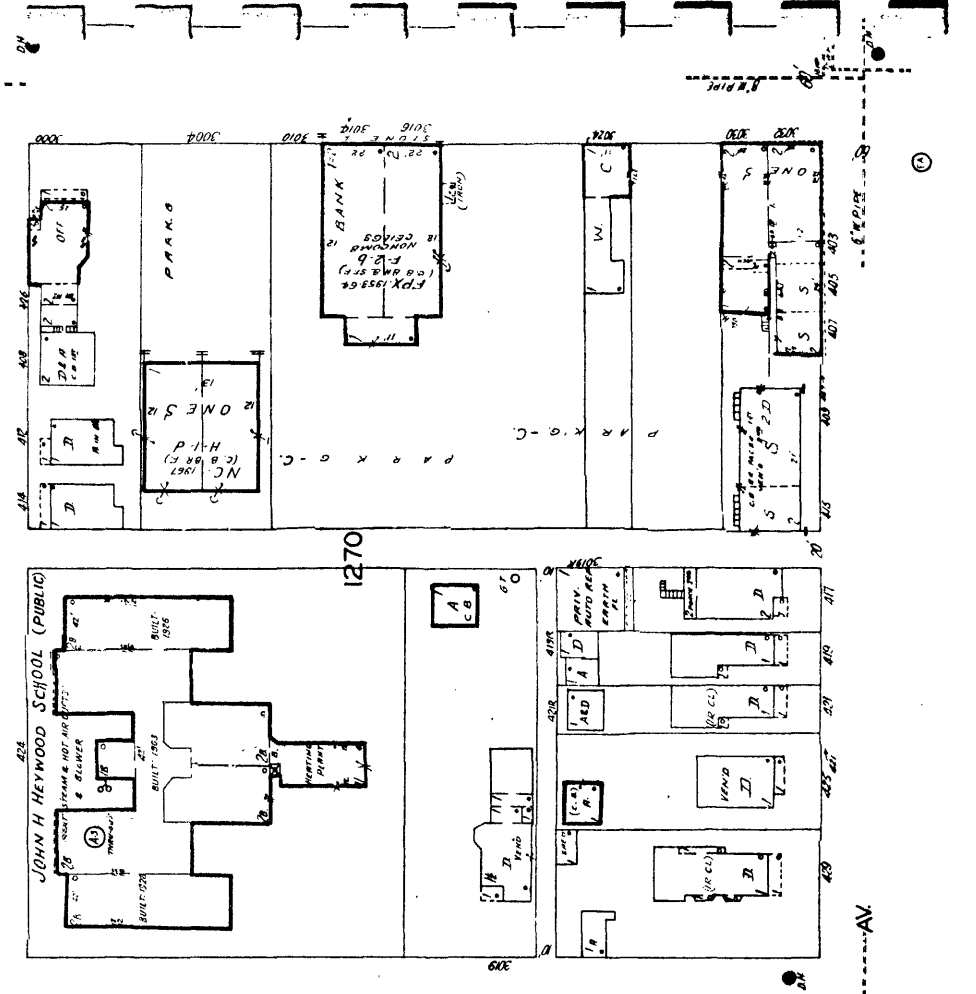
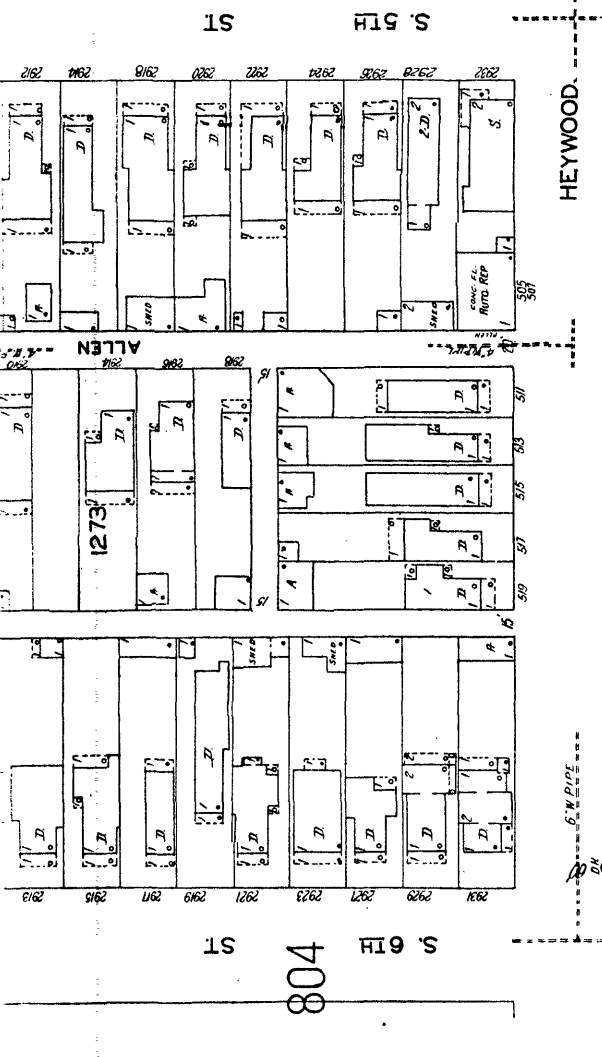
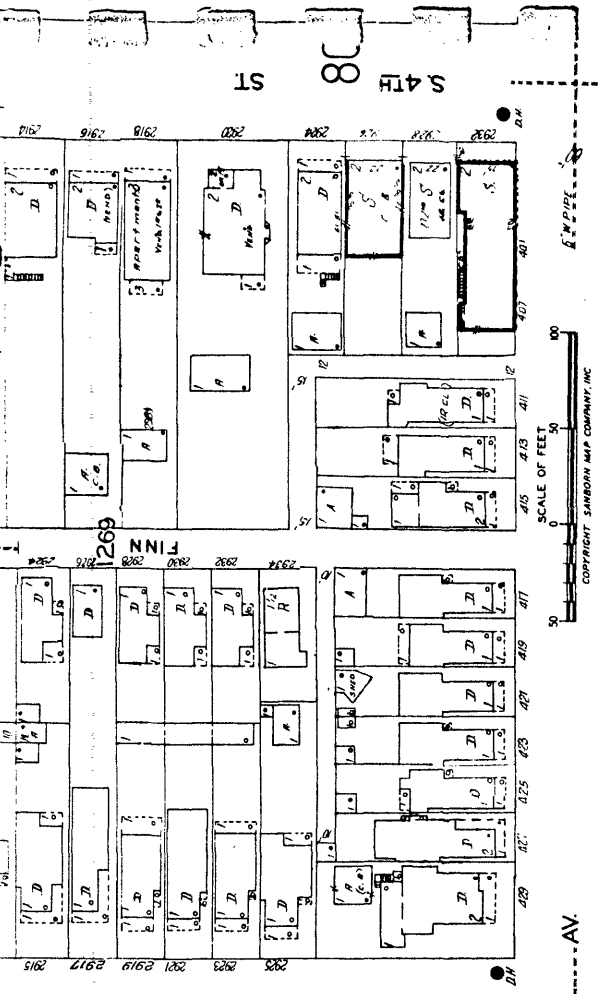
20. Significance

18. trave, dentil course, layered cornice and balustrade. The entry is flanked, on the main block of the building, by two-story arched openings containing tripart windows on both floors. Two simple windows with segmented stone lintels are located on the second floor above the stone entry. This fenestration is repeated on all facades of the original building. The wing additions contain no fenestration on the Heywood Ave. facades. The ends of the building, however, are symmetrical, with a double door and transom light entry on the first floor flanked by single then four window groupings. The second floor fenestration is identical with a tripart window above the entry. The cornice is exceptional. A dentil course, block modillions, and layered moldings are capped by a ballustrade. This cornice was identically matched on the new wings.

19. the building surplus property, and Ninth and O Baptist Church purchased the property. The Church moved its elementary school to this location.

The building occupies City Block 50J Lot 43. The site contains the building described herein and surrounding lawn and paved areas to the rear.
