STATEMENT

This building is a representative example of small-scale commercial in the Italianate style, the chief feature being tall, narrow upper-story windows with decorative window hoods. It is a contributing feature in the row of which it is a part, which includes the early (1840's) Davenport Block (RD-W130), the Petersen's Sons' Warehouse (RD-W124) and Schick Express and Transfer Warehouse (RD-118-20).

DESCRIPTION

When Schauder's Hotel was constructed in 1876 by Louis Schauder, it was one of five hotels in a two block area of West Front Street: Schauder was also the proprietor of the adjacent "Perry Hotel." By the 1880's the Schauder operated a saloon and music hall, and advertised "nice clean rooms" for its patrons. The Schauder continued from this prime river front location until the turn of the century.
