ARCHITECTURAL DESCRIPTION: house has wide projecting eaves with modillions, brick quoins on corners of structure, interior has a variation of central hall with four rooms up and four rooms down; to rear is a two story garage with servants quarters upstairs, landscaped with grass and hedge. Situated in downtown c. 1890 residential area gone commercial, with Ralston Towers to west; fair condition.

DATES OF ALTERATIONS: In 1928, a brick facade was added to the entire house. Originally, this dwelling was a frame house.

AREAS OF SIGNIFICANCE: sole proprietor of the Georgia Lumber Company, a local wholesale lumber concern, and owner of Butts Lumber Company, a retail business in Phenix City, Alabama.
