McMakin's Tavern (or Inn), constructed over a three year period ca. 1790, was a stagecoach stop throughout the early 19th Century, as well as the center of a large plantation. The McMakin family sold the house in 1840 to Samuel Morgan, whose descendents still live there.

<u>Architecture</u>: McMakin's Tavern is a fine example of a South Carolina house in the Upcountry. An upcountry farmhouse, it is basically a twostoried clapboard single house with gable end chimneys. Although the exterior is rather simple, the interior displays elaborately carved woodwork in the Adam style.

<u>Agriculture & Commerce</u>: This structure was the center of McMakin's Plantation, which originally contained over 2000 acres of fertile and rather level farmland. There was once a complement of outbuildings around the house which included a forge, store, grist mill, cobbler's ship, weaving house, and wheelwright's shop.

Transportation: Mills' Atlas (1820) mentions McMakin's Tavern; its function as a stagecoach stop probably explains the purpose of dual entrances and parlors.
