constructed for the Morris Plan and the Central Union Bank. \checkmark While the thrift institution survives, the bank was apparently a victim of the 1929 Crash, an event which unfortunately coincided with the untimely erection of this skyscraper in 1929-30. The Hulman Company, a prominent Indiana name, acquired the building afterward, and it eventually became the home of the local utility company.

The building was erected according to the plans of the well-known Indianapolisfirm of McGuire and Shook. Hailed as Evansville's first tall building of the Modern Movement, the Hulman Building is noteworthy for its fine Art Deco ornament and its elegant, soaring quality. Its current owners have undertaken a recent restoration of the main banking room and plan further sympathetic renovations.
