Architect/Designer: Denis Julien Historical Theme(s): Exploration/Fur Trade (VI B4)
History of Structure: Inscription of initials "DJ" and year 1838 left on canyon wall in Whirlpool Canyon, possibly evidence of temporary campsite of Julien's while trapping in the area. Julien worked for Antoinette Robidoux at Ft. Uintah, 1837-38 and had a long career as a trapper and mountain man. Latest information indicates 1841 as the latest Julien inscription.

Evaluation of Structure: Historic Theme Contributing y Non-Contributing _____
National Register Criteria: A x B C D (Include integrity statement)

Retains integrity of setting and location, presently it is the only documented resource associated with this theme within Monument boundaries, aside from natural feature names from Powell's trip. He felt similar inscriptions on the Colorado River.

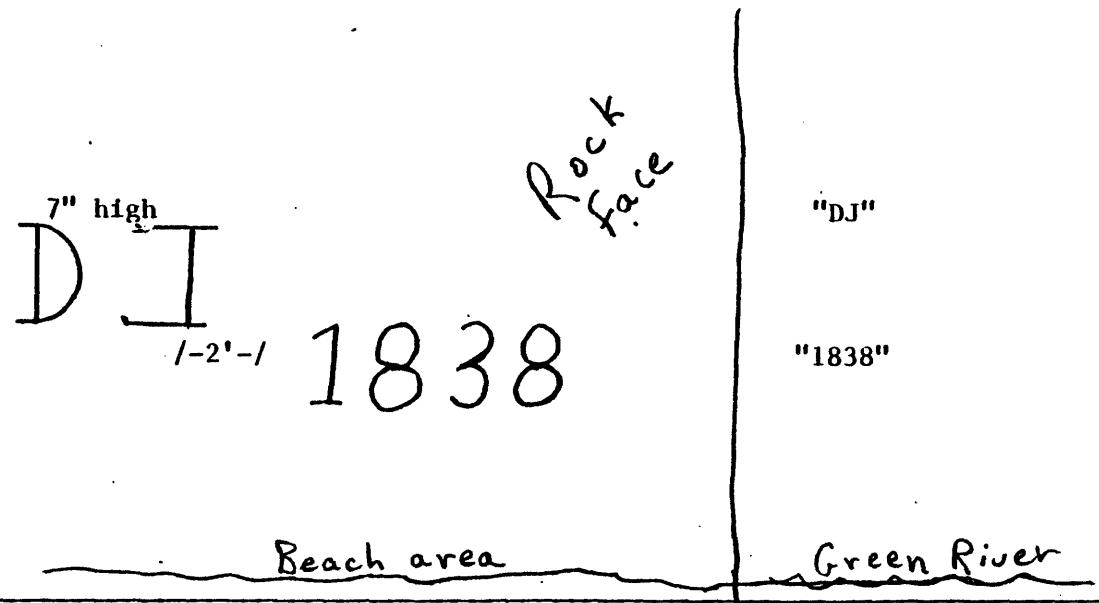
