
9. HELEN HUNT JACKSON BRANCH

2330 Naomi St.


This was the smallest Branch building in the system. It is a wood frame structure by C.E. Noerenberg. The Spanish Colonial Revival style chosen for the exterior is compatible in scale to many of the smaller buildings in the neighborhood and was designed to simulate a residential appearance. Use of this style proved particularly suitable for smaller institutional buildings compared to Classical Revival or other period revival styles used on larger public buildings.
