



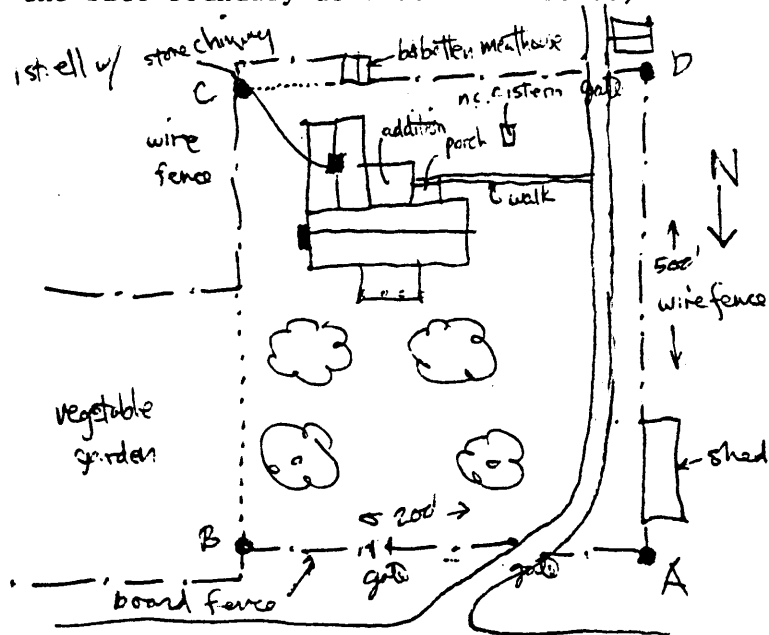

Verbal Boundary Description _____ Acreage 1 acre

Point A is located 350 feet northwest of the northwest corner of the house. Beginning at Point A on the south side of highway 1183, proceeding 200 feet east along a fence to Point B, thence with a fence and line aligned with fence 500 feet south to Point C, thence west 200 feet along a fence and line aligned with fence to Point D, thence 500 feet along fence to point of origin. The boundaries were chosen to enclose domestic-related space. No contributing outbuildings. The site contains one contributing building and one non-contributing structure (cistern).
