Two-story, irregularly fenestrated commercial building facing west towards railroad tracks. First story has three irregularly spaced single doors with transoms and five one-over-one windows all with segmental arches and one recessed double-door entrance with large multi-paned display windows. Fenestration on the second story consists of seven evenly-spaced four-over-four windows with segmental arches. A three-paneled rectangular parapet with corbeled cornice caps the building. A modern shed roof with modest square posts and brackets cover a gallery on the first floor. A one-story, three-bay appendage is attached to the rear of the building at the northeast corner.
