

HISTORY: (cont.) to as the Glen Cottage Tract. A later deed(1897) refers to the property as the Dr. Bascom farm. John Jones died leaving the property to his widow, Mrs. A. C. Jones whose name shows on the 1877 Beers map. However, Mrs Jones married Benjamin Pile 10 May 1877. At their death Mrs. Elizabeth Gregory acquired the property and sold to John W. Hughes, father of the present owner.(20 Sept. 1897).

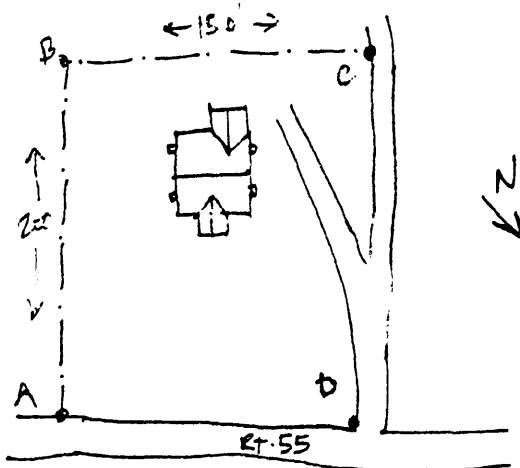

Verbal Boundary Description Acreege approx. 1 1/2 acres

The site is bounded by Ky. 55 on the northeast, a private drive on the northwest, and fences on the southeast and southwest, and it includes the house and its domestic-related space. No outbuildings. Beginning at A, southwest along the 200' to B, thence northwest 150' along the fence to C, thence northeast 200' along a fence to D, thence southeast 150' along the southwest side of KY 55 to the point of origin.

The nominated area includes one contributing building.
