The site is bounded by Ky. 55 on the northeast, a private drive on the northwest, and fences on the southeast and southwest, and it includes the house and its domestic-related space. No outbuildings. Beginning at A, southwest along the 200' to B, thence northwest 150' along the fence to C, thence northeast 200'along a fence to D, thence southeast 150' along the southwest side of KY 55 to the point of origin.
