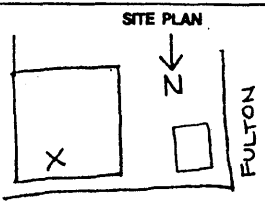

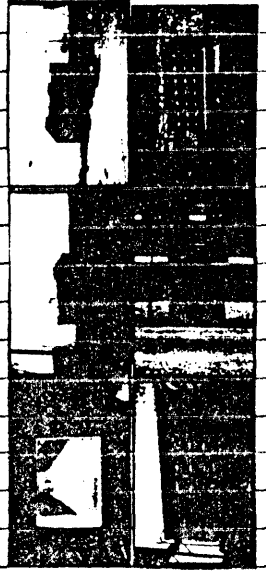

The association of ~~the~~ this building with the Orr family makes it an outstanding resource. From the arrival of Irish emigrant Samuel Orr in Evansville in 1835, the Orr family has been at the center of the city's commercial, social, and political progress. The Orr's iron trade dates back to the beginning of the family's presence in Evansville, the iron business carried out originally in combination with the Orrs' wholesale grocery concern. The building in question was erected in 1912 according to the plans of architect Harry E. Boyle & Company.
