Exterior: Original two story pine clapboard structure existing c. 1775-1780. Additions (c. 1830) included front and side porch, extension of back porch, and rear wing producing L-shaped effect. Pegged windows are 9/9 double sash. Original shingled roof has been replaced by tin. House has pipe stem chimney, unusual for area. Structure has three porches--those on the east and south are both two-story with four square paneled columns. (Southern side has smaller proportions.) Eastern portico has variegated moulding within pediment. Northern porch is covered, single story, supported by columns.

Interior: Originally consisted of five rooms with center hall-three rooms downstairs, two upstairs. Additions c. 1830 included four rooms--two on each floor. Brick storage area located beneath floor of rearmost room. At one time stairs in wing led to a "guest room" inaccessible to the rest of the house. Original door hinges and locks are in use. Shiplap walls and pegged construction characterize structure.

One owner converted structure into four apartments. The present owner is removing this work and beginning restoration.

Surroundings: This property is in imminent danger due to the possible construction of a six lane highway through the front of the yard area. Part of the land, the well, and two magnolia trees on either side of the entrance walk may be lost. The character of the property itself will be affected if the trees and well are destroyed.

About 1830 English gardener landscaped formal garden for front and side area; old brick remains. (Yard area includes large brick lined well c. 40 feet deep; also brick lined hole used for cooling foods during storage.)

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			

Dating from the Revolutionary War era, the Hammond House is one of the oldest residences in North Augusta. The house exemplifies a typical architectural trend of 19th Century South Carolina: that of converting plain 18th Century folk houses into more fashionable, columned homes as prosperity was attained.

Architecture: As possibly the oldest house in North Augusta, the Hammond home retains architectural qualities characterizing the utilitarian practicality of the Revolutionary period as well as the elegance of the early 19th Century. Such features as the graceful porticoes, the pegged construction, and the general plan of the house all combine to produce a sturdy, yet pleasing structure. An outstanding feature of the house is the pipe stem chimney which is not usually seen in South Carolina homes.

Military: Charles Hammond, from all evidence the first owner of the house, was credited with "Patriotic Service" (DAR Patriot both for his military record in Virginia and in South Carolina during the Revolutionary War. His grandson Charles Hammond, who inherited the Hammond house, served as a lieutenant in South Carolina's Revolutionary forces.
