DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The structure is not much changed from the original except that it has been covered by Beaver Lake since 1966. In times of low water, the upper part of the structure is visible and accessible.

W. H. "Coin" Harvey had intended to build a structure which would contain the history and artifacts of his historical period, and he determined that a pyramid would be the most logical type of structure for that purpose. To that end he began constructing a structure which resembled a pyramid in its concept, but in fact was only a facade on the side of a small hill. The facade included various vaults which were to contain the history and times of his Era. thus chronicling the end of the American experiment.

The structure was built of concrete, overlaid with natural stone, and included steps ascending between the rows of vaults. It was so constructured that the repositories could be utilized as benches, thus the whole thing could be used as an amphitheater. The structure is built on a northwest-southeast axis with the open side to the northeast.

The structure was never completed, for the project came to an end with the death of Harvey in 1936. Still, work had progressed to the point that this unique structure could be and was used as an amphitheater. A nearby girls school, now defunct, used the theater for production of plays, skits, and entertainment programs. The lower portion of the theater had a flat, paved surface built around a natural spring, and the whole project enjoyed much attention and use until the impoundment of the White River created Beaver Lake, and inundated the site.

Associated with the site was a resort with two of the largest log hotels in the world, built in 1904. Other development included an indoor swimming pool, a golf course, a casino, dance pavilion, a bowling alley, and park areas.

BUILDER/ARCHITECT W. H. "Coin" Harvey

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The significance of Monte Ne is tethered to the significance of its originator, W. H. "Coin" Harvey. As such, Monte Ne is significant as an example of the despair of the depression and the crushed dreams of one of America's foremost reformers. "Coin" Harvey was an idealist, a man who believed not only in the United States but in the perfectability of our society. He was born in West Virginia in 1851 and became a schoolmaster at the age of 16; later he practiced law, established a real estate business, and owned a silver mine. In 1894, he became a newspaper writer and the same year, wrote a book, "Coin's Financial School," which sold two million copies its first year in print. The book advocated free coinage of silver and was the basis for William Jennings Bryan's presidential campaign in 1896.

In the early 1900's, Harvey discovered a small valley in northwest Arkansas, bought 320 acres, and renamed the small community that was there Monte Ne, meaning "mountain waters." He developed a resort complex with a six-mile private railroad into the valley. Guests were then transferred to gondolas to make the half-mile trip down a lagoon to the resort hotels. Despite the impressiveness of the resort, the resort failed, primarily to inaccessibility.

After this failure, Harvey again turned his interest to political/ economic interests and prophesied the end of our civilization due to political corruption and inevitable wars. Then, in 1920, he had an idea to build a pyramid to house information that would tell future generations the story of the fall of this civilization. The pyramid was to be 130 feet high so it would be visible when erosion completely filled the valley. The top of the structure would have a plate with this message written in many languages, "When this can be read, go below and find the cause of the death of a former civilization."

In 1930, Harvey wrote another book, "The Book," which told of how the United States could achieve prosperity in 90 days. About the same time, he organized the "Liberty Party," and held a national convention at Monte Ne, and at 80 years of age, became a presidential nominee. The platform of the party was to control the citizen's wealth and insure against depression. After his defeat, he was short on finances and at




The remains of Harvey's dream are limited to the partial pyramid in the shape of an amphitheater 15 feet long and 50 feet wide. The 20-foot high structure is a silent reminder of a unique man and his contribution to history.
