

#### NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION

The #7 Morehead Voting House is located on a large flat urban lot in the city of Morehead. The #7 voting house was constructed of ashlar stone with beaded mortar. Exposed beams project from the original raised seam tin roof. One over one windows are placed on the north and south elevations, with three 2' x 2' single lights under the east gable eave. The windows have ashlar cut stone sills, but lack lintels. The three lights on the east elevation were positioned high to give light and to insure privacy to citizens voting in the three booths located under the windows. Victorian beaded boards seal the gable ends between the stone walls and roof. A capped yellow brick chimney is located at the center of the roof ridge.

#### NARRATIVE STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The #7 Morehead Voting House meets criterion A and is a significant physical representation of the New Deal. It was constructed by the WPA and used exclusively as a voting house during the period of significance. The #7 Morehead Voting House has retained a majority of the original materials and is recognizable in function as a voting house. The #7 Morehead Voting House is located in its original setting and location, and has retained its integrity of association as a building constructed by one of the New deal era agencies.
