




American Legation Tangier, Morocco

The antique painted doors and ceilings and the mosiac tile floor were taken by Blake from old Moroccan buildings and incorporated in the pavilion. On the walls are a few of the historic engravings of Morocco on permanent loan from Mr. Donald Angus. Mr. Angus a former American resident of Tangier, assembled a vast collection of en-

gravings, aquatints, etchings and other prints of Morocco about one hundred of which are on display.
