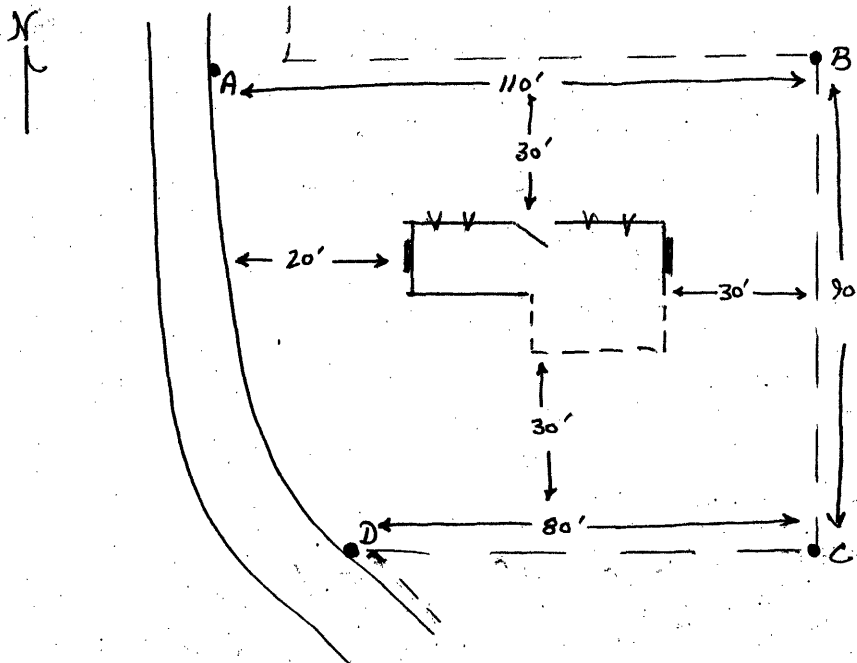
Verbal Boundary Description
