

Physical Description

This rectangular two-story commercial building with flat roof is constructed of native rock-faced sandstone, thus blending in harmoniously with the rest of Batesville's downtown commercial district. The upper part of second story on the front elevation is faced with dark red brick; creating a rich contrast in color and texture with the native stone. A decorative effect is created through the use of stone trim in the manner of a Gibbs surround of the upper windows and through the effect of stone quoins created by stones wrapping around the side elevation and appearing on the front. A simple smooth stone band is inset just beneath the parapet, and smooth stone lintels mark the second story windows. The upper windows appear singly, those on the lower story are grouped in pairs flanking the double leaf door. All windows are plate glass sash.

Statement of Significance

The two-story Dondy Building in downtown Batesville, Arkansas, was designed by Theo Sanders in 1918. Constructed of native rock-faced sandstone, the Dondy Building is typical of many of the older commercial structures in the city which are also of rock construction. The second story features an unusual blend of red brick and sandstone, creating a decorative effect in the otherwise plain expanse of stone walls. One of the more unusual commercial designs represented in the drawing collection, the Dondy Building blends harmoniously with the fabric of downtown Batesville, and reveals the designer's sensitivity to compatible designs well-integrated with their environment.


