The interior of the building is approached by four major stairways, each with monumental stone handrails and newel posts that once supported elaborate light fixtures. Hallway floors are of marble, and wainscoting is of Ettawa pink marble from Georgia. Most woodwork is oak. Other interior features include brass hardware and handrails, iron railings, four full-height light shafts, molded plaster, and much of the original carved wood judges' benches, jury boxes and railings. A central feature is the rotunda, which is open from the
