DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The B. H. Campbell House in Wichita is a two-story irregularly shaped structure with a full basement and an attic. The building faces east and is approximately 60 feet long and 75 feet deep with an overall height of 40 feet.

The exterior walls are constructed of rough-hewn stone blocks laid in uniform horizontal courses. The stone lengths are random. The height of the horizontal courses decreases as they rise above the ground line, reducing the massiveness of the building as the walls rise. Three enormously large courses of stone blocks demark the basement portion of the house.

The steep hip roof is covered with asphalt shingles. A simple cornice separates the roof from the stone walls. Small dormers and gables as well as several stone chimneys break the roof line. The dormers are used to provide light to the attic which is behind the hip roof. The roof ridges are decorated with ornamental cast iron ridge caps. A large circular tower is located at the northeast corner of the house. This stone tower is decorated with stone laid in a checkerboard pattern and with a castellated roof line.

Windows on all floors are generally rectangular with no special treatment at the head or sills. At the top of the tower are circular windows surrounded by circular arches. Semicircular window openings occur in the gable ends of the roof. A large arched porch is located on the south side and is connected to a covered drive. A large two-story stone barn still stands on the grounds. It features a circular stone tower on the south side.

The exterior of the house is believed to be basically as it was originally.

The B. H. Campbell House in Wichita was built in 1888 for Col. Burton Harvey Campbell, a prominent Kansas cattleman, who was widely known as "Barbecue" Campbell. Born in 1829 at Randolph, New York, he was in the lumber business in New York City for a number of years. He acquired the title of "Colonel" when the U. S. government utilized his business knowledge in Reconstruction activities in the South after the Civil War. Campbells moved to Kane county, Illinois, where they purchased a farm and began breeding cattle, horses and sheep. Because of his interest in purebred cattle, Campbell helped organize, and served as the first secretary of, the American Short Horn Breeders Association, which created a system of registering the ancestry of cattle.

In the late 1870's Campbell sold his stock and land and moved to Kansas to start a cattle ranch. The Campbells lived in Hutchinson for one year and then moved to Wichita in 1881. established a ranch south of Caldwell in the Cherokee Strip until the cattlemen were evicted from the area by the Secretary of the Interior. Then he leased land from the Creek Indian Nation in Indian Territory until 1891 when he moved his ranching activities to Clark county, Kansas. Probably the most widely known ranch with which Campbell was associated was the famous XIT Ranch in In 1885 the Capitol Freehold Land and Investment Co., Ltd., established a three million-acre ranch, which Campbell managed until 1887.

Although he was away from Wichita for many years, that city remained his permanent home and the residence of his wife and family after 1881. In 1888 on the west bank of the Little Arkansas river he had constructed a 14-room mansion which is still considered one of the showplaces of the city. Several architects worked on plans for the structure which reportedly took two years to complete. The exterior was built of stone imported from the East and the interior woodwork and floors were of mahogany, walnut, oak and cherry woods.

The Campbell family occupied the large stone house until the deaths of Col. and Mrs. Campbell in 1908 and 1907.

The Campbell house was for many years one of Wichita's showplace residences. It is an excellent example of Victorian residential architecture executed in native limestone.
