The Kendall Young Public Library, one of the truly distinctive libraries in Iowa, far surpasses other classical libraries in its lavishness. The from facade is predominantly rusticated masonry. This is found on the bevelled corners, which reflect the diagonal corners of the reading rooms, and the wide center pavilion with its convex sides. The distyle portico is in a florid Ionic order, with much relief decoration in the entablature and the pediment. The interior (Plan Type III) is equally elaborate. The delivery room is domed in stained glass and separated from the reading rooms by screens of square marble columns. The reading rooms feature deep plaster cornices and coved ceilings. In one rear corner is an art reference room (now used as an office) with walls panelled in wood.
