DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

St. James Episcopal Church is a good example of an English country church of the Gothic style rendered in brick. Its gabled roof has triangular stained glass dormers and a white shingled belfry at the front. The belfry rises from two buttress-like piers which frame a large stained glass Gothic window which contains a rose window. Brick buttresses accent corners and demarcate the four side bays, each of which contains a stained glass lancet window.

The original wood and plaster interior with its open ceiling, is still intact, and the original pews still are used.

The building has undergone certain alterations. In the mid-1950's a rear chapel was added, which does not detract from the original design. The belfry originally had a spire, but due to structural difficulties it had to be removed. The front doors have recently been replaced.
