REMEMBERS THE VALOR AND DEVOTION OF
HER SONS WHO SERVED AT FORT DONNELSON
AND OTHER ENGAGEMENTS OF THIS THEATER
OF THE CIVIL WAR.

DURING THE BATTLE AT FORT DONNELSON
FEBRUARY 12-16, 1862 COL. JOHN GREGG'S
7TH TEXAS INFANTRY OF DAVIDSON'S
CORPS, JOHNSON'S DIVISION, WERE THE
VICTIM OF A GALLANT ENEMY WHICH BROVE
THE ENEMY FROM A HILL UNDER THE
FIRE AND SUPPORT OF CONFEDERATE GENERAL
GREGG'S ATTACK ON THE FEDERAL GARRISON
AT FORT DONNELSON, FEBRUARY 3, 1863, THE
23RD TEXAS CAVALRY, TERRY'S TEXAS RANGERS
OF WHARTON'S BRIGADE, SET UP A ROAD BLOCK
RANGERS SET UP A ROAD BLOCK AND SUCCESSFULLY
STOPPED THE UNION LINE AND REINFORCED THE
FROM REACHING THE BATTLE AREA. ALTHOUGH
COL. TERRY WAS KILLED AT THE BATTLE OF
BOYD'S HILL MORE THAN A YEAR BEFORE
THIS BATTLE THE RANGERS CONTINUED TO BE
KNOWN AS TERRY'S TEXAS RANGERS TO THE
END. GEN. HANDELMAN'S SPECIAL
ORDER SAID OF TERRY: HIS
REGIMENT BECAME THE LOSS OF A BRAVE
AND ELICITED COMMANDER THE ARMED ONE OF
US ABLEST OFFICERS.

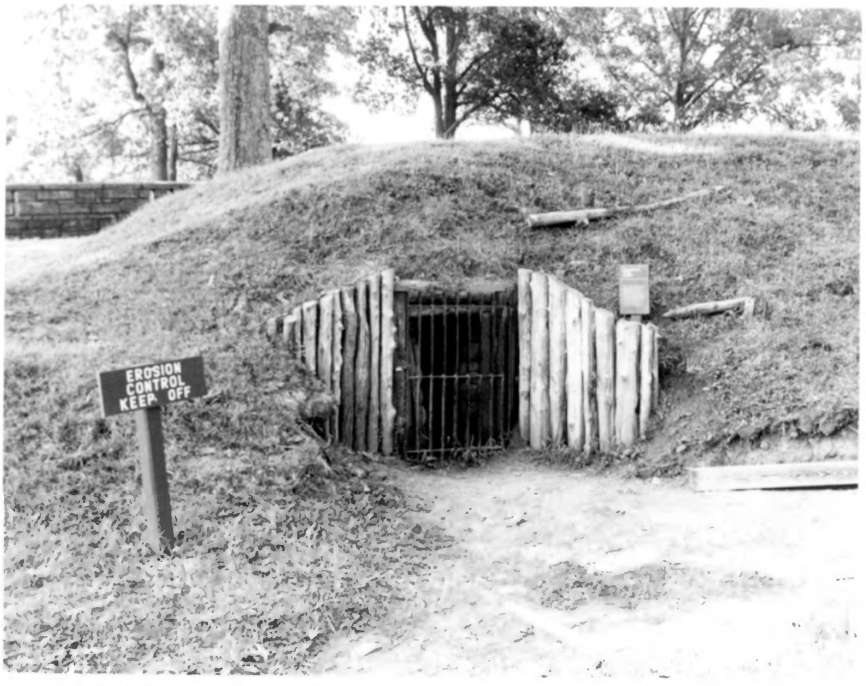

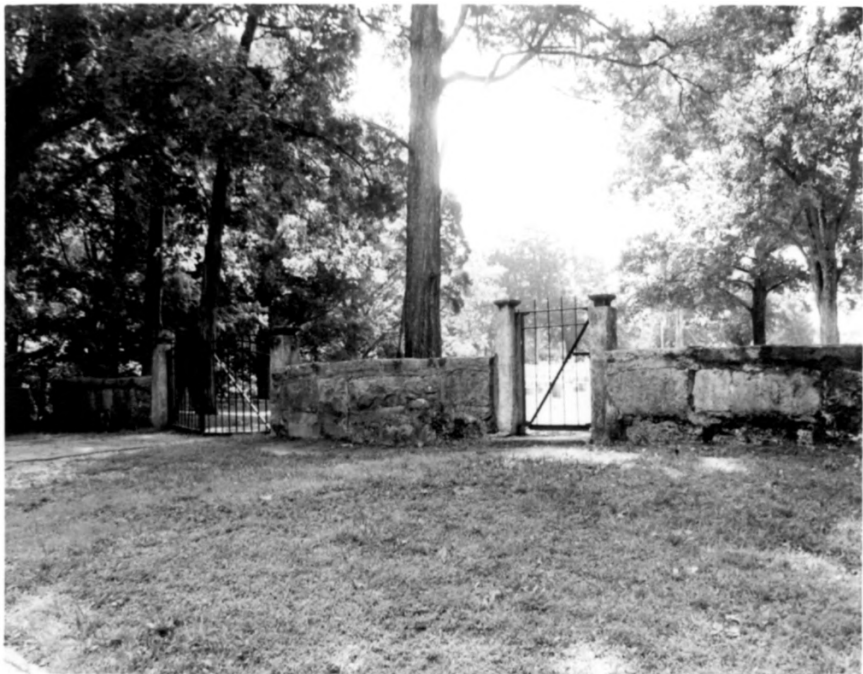

54TH VIRGINIA, LIEUT. COLONEL J. WILSON PERU
50TH VIRGINIA, MAJOR CHARLES F. DICKERSON
20TH MISSISSIPPI, MAJOR WILLIAM H. SMITH

PROCEEDING FROM CUMBERLAND CITY TO FORT LINDSEY
THE BRIGADE ARRIVED AT LATELY, FEBRUARY 10, 1862
AT ONCE OCCUPIED A POSITION IN SUPPORT OF GREEN'S
BATTERY, ON THE LEFT OF LAWSON'S BRIGADE. THE 20TH
MISSISSIPPI REMAINED IN POSITION THROUGH THE BATTLE
THE REGIMENT WERE ORDERED TO WITHDRAW. GENERAL PELLOW
ORDERED THE 20TH MISSISSIPPI TO REINFORCE THE 7TH ILLINOIS
REGIMENT IN THE TRENCHES.
