Armory Hall became the full-time City Hall in 1956. Since that time it has been politically significant as a gathering point for groups to discuss the town's future.

The social-humanitarian significance is derived from the fact that Armory Hall was <u>the</u> social center for Aspen. Prior to full-time use as City Hall it was used as a fraternal hall. Lodge meetings for various fraternal organizations were frequently held here. (Mining groups also used Armory Hall as a meeting place.) Most social events associated with these various meetings took place here, along with many others.
