One-story frame T-plan dwelling. Three bay with center entrance which has one pane transom. Bay window placement on facade and windows are 2/2 pane with denticated cornice. One-story, two bay porch enhanced by gingerbread trim with finials. Double window placement on facade consisting of long and narrow straight-headed windows of 2/2 pane with architrave trim. Facade gable pierced by double-placed rounded ventilators with hood molds. Each gable end also pierced by rounded ventilators with hoodmolds and completed by finial on cornice. Side windows 2/2 pane with architrave trim. Two bay dormers on each side

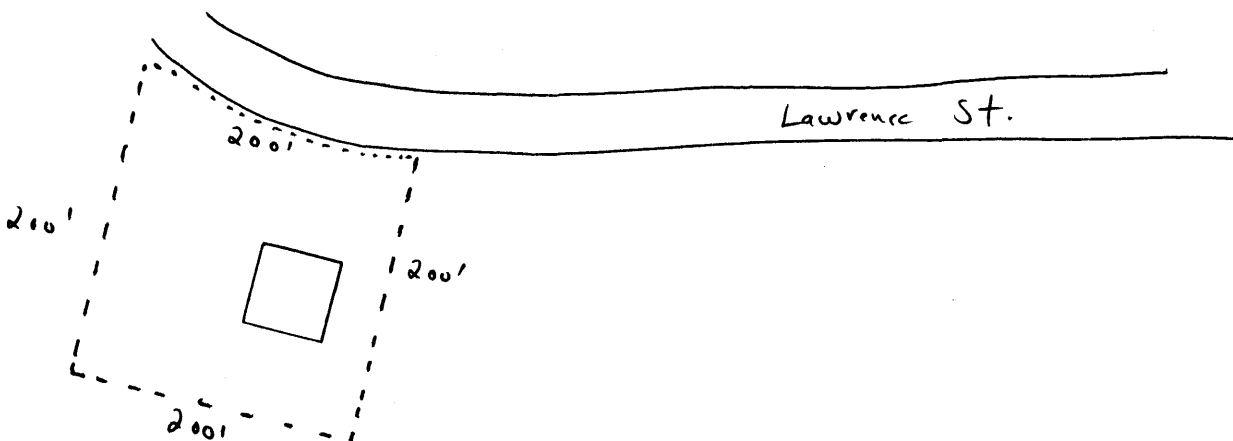

Beginning at a point on the south side of Lawrence Street, approximately 100 feet from the center of the house, proceed 200 feet in a southwestward direction; thence 200 feet in a northwestward direction; thence 200 feet in a northeastward direction; thence 200 feet in a southeastward direction along the south side of Lawrence Street to the point of origin.
