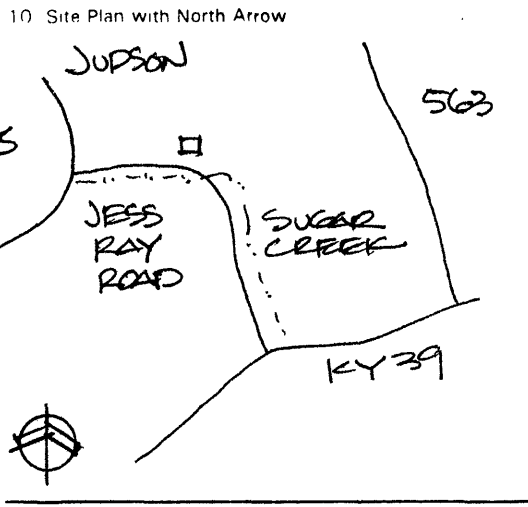

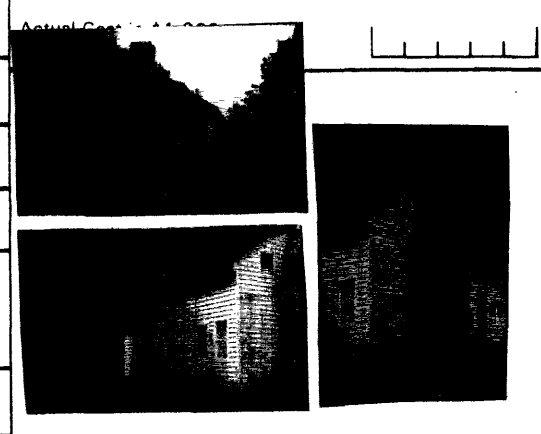

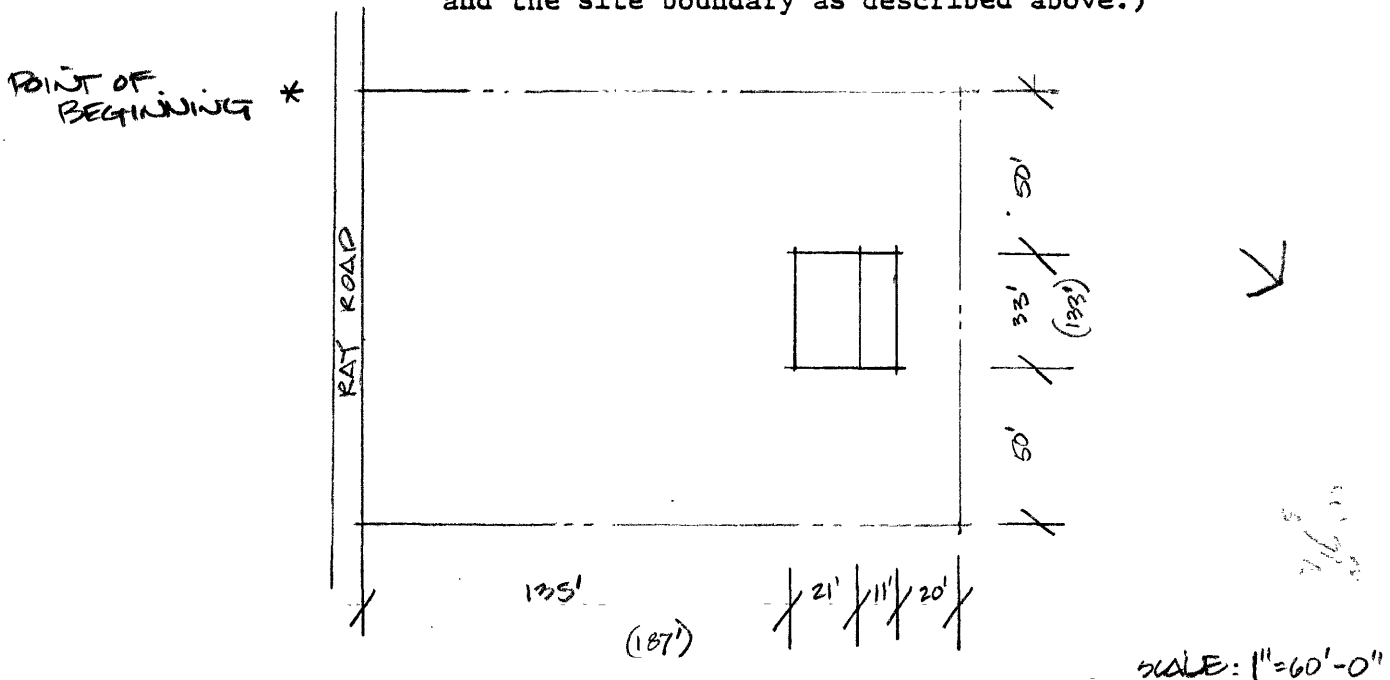

Verbal Boundary Description Acreage .57

From a point in Ray Road then North 187 feet to a point; then East 133 feet to a point, then South 187 feet to a point; then West with Ray Road 133 feet to the point of beginning.

Point of beginning in Ray Road is 50 feet west and 187 feet south of the south corner of the Ray House.
