This frame building on a stone foundation is sheathed in board and batten and roofed in tin. The vertical board and batten, tall and pointed windows, and steep roof all demonstrate an early Gothic style, which was just becoming popular in the 1850s when it was built. The main part is 18' x 34'; the ell is 14' x 12' and the vestibule 5' x 7'. A little earth brown paint has survived the weathering. The structure is sound enough to merit restoration. Its location provides a panorama of the Mississippi River.



STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

What is now called the Emanuel Evangelical Lutheran Church is believed to be the first public building, and one of the first frame buildings, in Brownsville. Bryant's History of Houston County refers to it as "....the first public building which was called the Town Hall and was used as a church and schoolhouse and is now the Methodist Episcopal Church. In this building, in May, 1857, Miss M.U.Wells began a school". Charles Brown, one of the two pioneering brothers to settle Brownsville in 1848 is given credit for building this church. Both local citizens and the county historical society wish to acquire and preserve this survivor of the era in order to prevent its falling into the hands of disinterested persons.




