The H.C. Shiflett Barn, located on Hickman Road, Georgetown, Tennessee, was listed in the National Register of Historic Places on July 6, 1982. This property, which included a c. 1866 two-story, double pen, log cantilever barn, was listed under Criterion C for local architectural significance as an unusual method of construction, nominated under the Historic Resources of Meigs County, Tennessee Multiple Resource Area document. The barn was demolished October 27, 2016. As a result, the H.C. Shiflett Barn has lost the significance for which it was listed and no longer retains integrity of location, setting, materials, design, feeling, workmanship, or association. Therefore, the H.C. Shiflett Barn should be removed from the National Register.




2016 USGS Topographical Map (Birchwood 119-SW) with location of H.C. Shiflett Barn. Original map at 1:24000 scale.




Parcel map with National Register boundary for H.C. Shiflett Barn. *Source: National Register nomination, 1979.*







Verbal Boundary Description and Justification:

41. The boundaries begin at a point on the north side of the road 1000 feet northeast of the fork in Fisher Hollow Road, thence northeast along said road 150 feet, thence northwest 200 feet, thence southwest 150 feet, thence southeast 200 feet to the beginning. This boundary takes the form of a rectangle which encompasses the barn. Due to the lack of property lines or visual boundary lines on the northeast, northwest, and southwest sides, imaginary boundary lines were established to include the barn and approximately .7 acres of land on which it sits.
