Description Situated on a rise overlooking the Cloverport-Hawesville Road (U.S.60), the Oglesby-Conrad House is a one and one-half story brick structure with a single-story brick ell. The facade is five bays wide with a center entrance which originally had a transom and sidelights now enclosed. 18. remainder is executed in common bond brickwork with a row of headers every five rows. The brickwork is unique in that the first sixteen rows of the facade and the first seventeen rows of the west side are laid in common bond, and completed in Flemish bond brickwork. Facade windows are 9/6 pane with jack arches. Three pedimented dormer windows enhance the facade. Side and rear windows also are accented by jack arches. The main block is set off by interior gable-end chimneys with two 2/2 pane gable windows on each end, and the ell also has an interior gable-end chimney. Three ground level ventilators with limestone lintels and sills and accented by jack arches above the lintels pierce the facade. The rear is accented by two pedimented dormer windows of 1/1 pane.

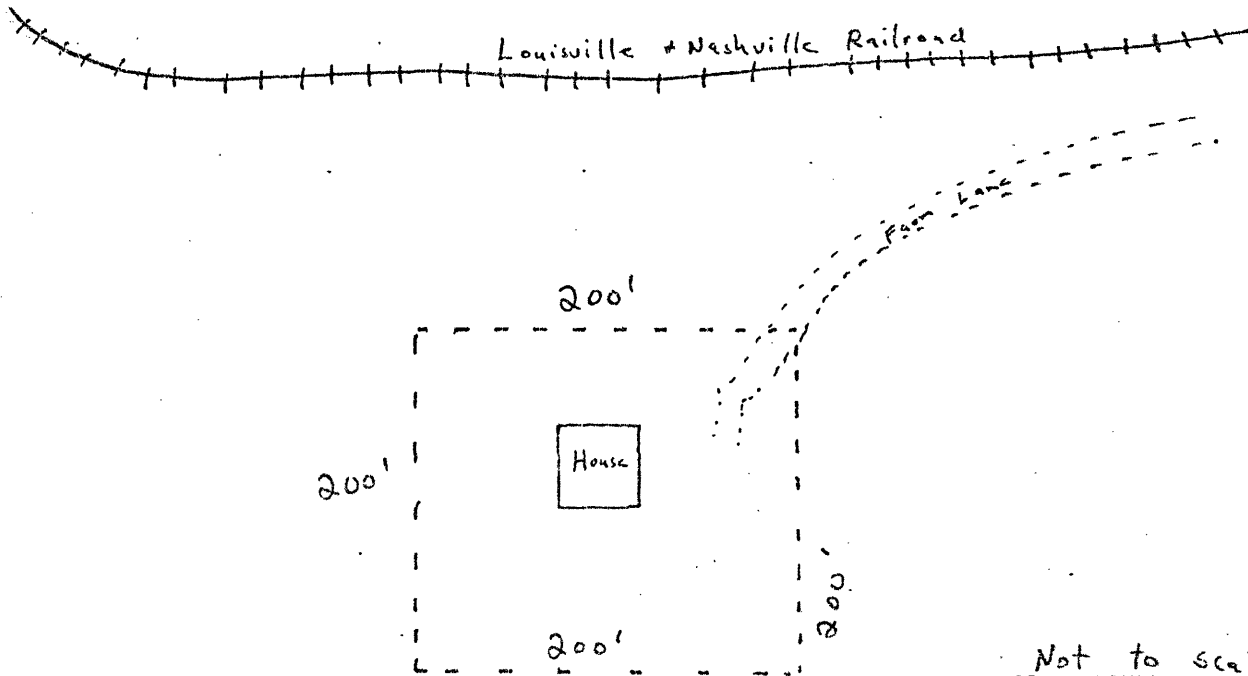

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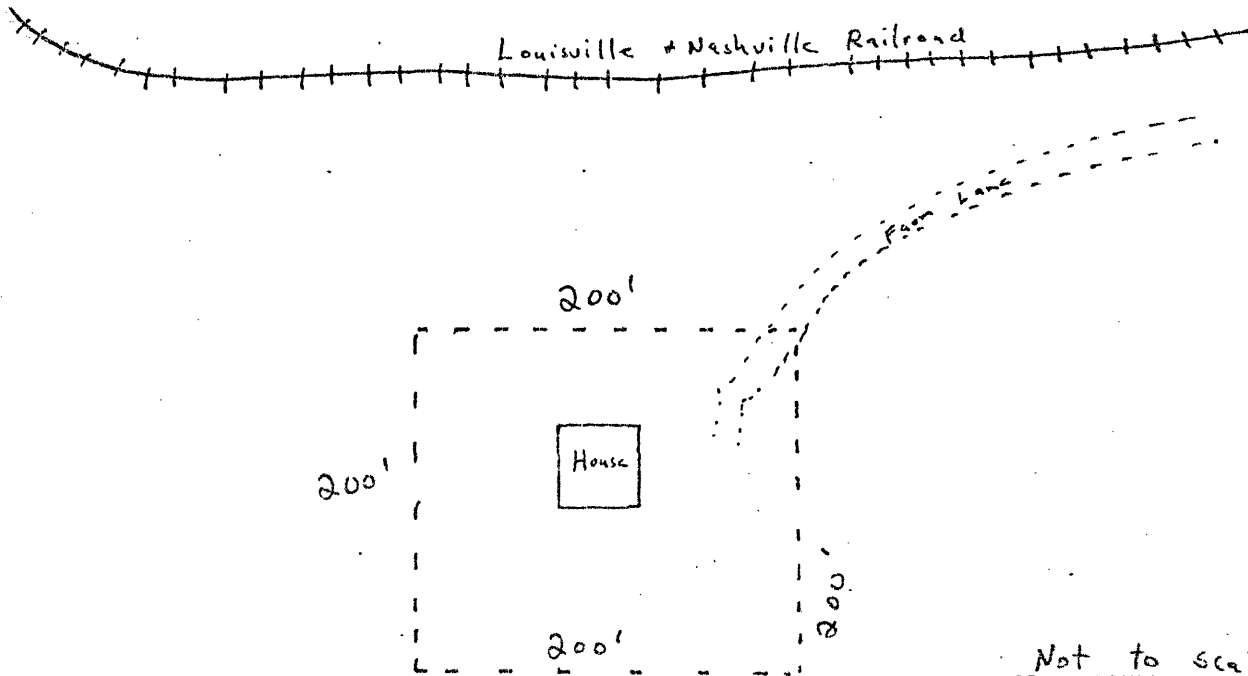
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
