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Description

During the Railroad Era (1870-1914) in White County a variety of vernacular buildings were constructed. They were also built out of a variety of materials. Surviving examples from this period, however, are somewhat limited. The Ben Lightle House is a good example of a Folk Victorian House. It is two-stories in height, irregularly-shaped and is of frame construction. The walls are clad with novelty siding. The hipped roof terminates with either gable or gable on hip wings that are covered with composition shingles. The entire structure rests on brick piers.

Located on the southeast corner of N. Locust and E. Market Streets, this building was constructed three blocks southeast of the courthouse in Searcy. The Ben Lightle House was built in 1898 and is in good condition. Its main, or north elevation plays host to a one-story one-bay porch. This porch has a hipped roof that is supported by turned posts. Other details found on this porch include a balustrade, decorative spindle work and a one-bay porch that rests on top of the hipped roof porch. Both porches are accessed by single centrally placed doors. Fenestration found on the house consists of single or paired two-over-two double-hung wood sash windows that are symmetrically arranged. A lone centrally placed one-over-one double-hung sash window relieves the upper portion of the gable end on the south elevation of the structure. Extending from the northeast corner of the house is a square one-story bay. The west elevation of the structure plays host to a one-story porch that has a gable roof; this porch is decorated in a similar fashion to the one on the main elevation of the house. A recessed one-bay porch is found on the west elevation of the rear gable roofed room. The only non-historic addition found on the structure is located on the western slope of this gable roofed room. The addition is a small shed roof dormer.

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Significance

Ben Lightle had this building constructed in 1898 after moving to Searcy from Carlisle in Lonoke County. When this house was built it was one of numerous irregularly-shaped houses constructed in White County during the Railroad Era (1870-1914). Although there are sixty-seven of these structures extant in the county, few exhibit the amount of integrity found in the Ben Lightle House. For this reason it is significant for its contribution to the study of vernacular architecture and is being nominated under Criterion C with local significance.
