DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The horse barn at the Idaho State School and Hospital is a 38' x 76' frame barn with a flared round roof. It has a set of centered sliding doors with a case-ment window of six lights and a door on either side. A vertical sliding hay door with a square, braced hood dominates the "gable" and is flanked by windows similar to those on the first story. A rectangular cupola with a flared round roof surmounts the building. A shed dormer breaks the roof on the north side.

There are 14 windows on the north side's first story and 15 on the south side.

The barn has a concrete floor, and a capacity for 20 horses. There have been no exterior alterations or additions. The interior also remains in excellent condition and unaltered.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The horse barn at the Idaho State School and Hospital is architecturally significant as an exceptionally well built and preserved round roofed barn. Its size, flared eaves and matching cupola make it an especially noteworthy example of this type. The round roofed barn is an occasional alternative to the gambrel in Idaho, especially after about 1915.

The Idaho State School and Hospital was founded in 1911 as a public sanitarium for mentally handicapped. An extensive building program undertaken in the early 1920s included a "modern" farm on which to train the patients.

Most of the hospital and school has undergone considerable alteration to meet today's standards. Thus the horse barn remains as one of the last extant representatives of its period on the grounds.
