The area to be nominated is roughly bounded by Sutter on the West, Monterey on the East, Carolina on the North and the alley south of York St. on the South. The buildings which have been photographed are those which are most significant and show the best the area has to offer. They are mainly the earliest homes in the earliest building styles. The later (Bungalow and Spanish Revival) styles are not photographed as they are familiar to most people.

The Victorian and turn of the century homes found in Vallejo are of several types. The first of these is the Italianate house. This house is distinguished by a narrow vertical appearance and a flat roof. The roofline is heavily bracketed. The entry and windows are accented by heavily carved detail of a classical nature. The siding is generally redwood.

The second type found in this area is the Queen Anne house. This home has a broader aspect and gabled roof. The design tended to be assymetrical and sometimes included a tower. Most houses have a bay window. The exterior was given interest by patterned shingles in the diamond, fishscale or other unique designs.

'The third style found in this area is the "Steep pitched roof" style.' These homes were built at the turn of the century and have a more austere look. The details are generally simpler than the earlier types, although they have patterned shingles.

The California Bungalow style is usually a one story home with projecting eves and heavy brackets under them. In many cases the wood siding is only two or three inches wide.

Built somewhat earlier, the Hip roof with a dormer window is also a distinct style with a blocky, symmetrical look.

The Mission or Spanish revival home is the only one that used stucco. These homes had arched windows and tile roofs.

Although the above styles of homes are the most common found in the area, there were many individual homes which comform to no set style. These were built to the wishes of the owner rather than the dictates of fashion.

It is our intention to nominate the entire area of homes, not just those photographed. The boundries of this area were set with several ends in mind. First, to define the core of the Victorian area. Then, the lines were changed somewhat for the sake of coherency (i.e., except in the case of Monterey St. and a portion of Carolina St., both sides of the streets are included). This was done because the City of Vallejo plans to zone this a historic area in order to preserve its integrity. Thus the entire street frontage would be protected. The block of Capitol Street between Sutter and Sonoma has been included because the street here gives way to a set of steep stairs. This block of stairs is planned by several private groups to be landscaped and dotted with statues of the city fathers which would ultimately make it the natural gateway to the area.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Old City area of Vallejo was the location of many of Vallejo's first Victorian homes. Because of the steep hill, the area was never developed commercially as the neighboring downtown business area expanded. Consequently, we find Vallejo's original residential area, verging on the community's major business district, that has remained an island while the community has grown around and beyond it.

Today the area is dotted with an array of excellent examples of Victorian architectures dating from the 1850's. While none of these homes were built on the grand and lavish scale often associated with the Victorian era, they are representative of the types of homes built in small and growing communities in the West during the last half of the 19th century. Many of these homes have been maintained through the years in their original appearance, while others have been allowed to fall into disrepair or have been remodeled and 'modernized" to the extent that they no longer give a hint of their original character. The original large plots of ground have in most cases been divided into smaller lots and other homes built on them. Thus today we find the area covered with homes built at various times from the 1850's up until 1965. In addition to the homes that have been well preserved, there are still a number of Victorian homes in the area, including some of the finest, that could easily be returned to original exterior condition.
