DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Located in Fort Collins, Colorado, the Midtown Historic District is a residential area that reflects the characteristic features of a middle-class farming community that developed in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The District includes 665 properties. Of these 549 contribute to the historic and architectural fabric that gives the District its integrity; another seventy-two are more modern buildings that are nonetheless compatible with the older structures; and another forty-four are intrusions that detract from the fabric of the area.

Although the boundary of the District is irregular, it is essentially rectangular in shape and may be readily justified. The northern boundary, the most highly irregular, is the line which delineates those blocks which have a high degree of integrity from those blocks which have a high degree of new commercial buildings, parking lots, and irreversibly altered historic structures. On the west the alleyway between Remington Street and College Avenue delineates the long row of homes that face Remington from the long row of commercial structures that face College. The southern boundary is marked off by Fort Collins High School, and the eastern boundary by the alleyway that runs east of Whedbee Street; to the south and east of these lines are homes that were built largely in the 1930s and after.

The Midtown Historic District developed over a sixty-year period, but throughout that time it retained a certain uniformity. A vast number of the structures are small, one-story brick or frame cottages rectangular in shape. They have few decorative elements, but are unmistakably late Victorian. On Remington Street, however, are a number of larger, more elaborate brick houses designed by local architects. These buildings clearly represent the Italianate, Queen Anne, Eastlake and other thrusts of Victorian architecture, as well they might, for they were constructed for the wealthier, more prominent people in the city. And finally, scattered through the District are schools, churches, and other buildings that characterize a residential neighborhood.

ATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Midtown Historic District is significant as an example of early community planning and development and for its role in the social evolution of Fort Collins. The District is also significant for its architectural features which show many small Victorian cottages as well as some very fine period homes built primarily along Remington Street for prominent citizens. All these, together with the old trees and foliage, reflect the ambiance of a late nineteenth/early twentieth century agricultural community.

Although there had been a military post, Camp Collins, established in the 1860s, the City of Fort Collins owed its existence to the movement to develop agricultural colonies on the high plains. In the early 1870s Horace Greeley, editor of the New York <u>Tribune</u>, had been instrumental in forming the Union Colony, which founded what is today the City of Greeley, Colorado. This experiment had hardly begun, however, when the leaders decided to establish a second agricultural colony which would be located some distance to the west on four square miles of land previously reserved for military use. This decision led to the organization of the Agricultural Colony at Fort Collins. The original streets laid out near the Camp in 1867 ran parallel to the Cache la Poudre River, but Franklin C. Avery, who platted the streets for the new colony drew his on a north/south and east/west axis. This eventually accounted for the so-called triangle area that formed the commercial center of the community (an area now listed in the Register), while much of the residential neighborhoods followed the north/south and east/west grid pattern.

The homes in the Midtown Historic District were built as the residential development moved south from the downtown area. The oldest known structure, the Coy House at 401 Mathews (c. 1876) is located in the northern section. Maps of the 1880s show that construction had progressed in this area although there was no systematic pattern of habitation. The houses were spread throughout the area though most were clustered on the northern edge. Some blocks had four to five dwellings on each side, but other blocks were used for farming. The 1880s, however, saw Remington Street emerge as a showcase for local architects who built homes there for the town's elite. The 1890s saw considerable building, but it remained in the northern two-thirds of the District. By the end of the decade some blocks were fully developed, and some of the larger lots in others were being subdivided.

The twentieth century witnessed a continuation of this pattern. The first decade saw expansion along the southern edge and a renewed interest in subdividing the larger lots of the more settled area. After 1910 this activity slowed because of a local depression and probably the effects of World War I. Fewer than thirty structures

rose in the District during this time, but the 1920s and 1930s witnessed an expanded development along the southern edge and the construction of a number of bungalow style homes. By the 1930s the area comprising the District was fully developed as a residential area and has remained such till the present day.

From an architectural perspective the District reflects the styles of the times. The most prevalent building type is the small Victorian cottage with few if any decorative elements. Yet on several blocks along Remington Street are a number of far more substantial homes that manifest the stylistic characteristics of the era: Italianate, Romanesque, Queen Anne, Eastlake, and others. Some of these were designed by Montezuma Fuller, the most important of the early architects in Fort Collins, a number of whose buildings are now listed in the Register. And finally, there are a number of bungalow style structures which fit in well and depict the change in architectural styles over this long period of construction.
