DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED: The William Talley home is the finest example of Spanish Colonial Revival style in Safford. It is traditional with focal windows which are triple arched, parabolic in shape and multi-paned. The roof sheathing is red Mission tile. Unique design features include heavy plank front entry with brick surround. There is also a shed roof porch to the right side with triple round arches which match the window openings. This home is a distinct and imposing residence in Safford. It was the home of prominent Safford lumberman William Talley.
