## RESUBMISSION WILLCOX MRA

Joe Mee House (265 W. Stewart)
Cochise County
ARIZONA

This nomination was returned for substantive reasons. Originally, the Mee House was nominated under criteria "B" (Ranching) and "C" (Architecture). However, the Register's reviewer felt that "C" was justified but that criterion "B" was not. Also, since Joe Mee was the first owner of this Craftsman Bungalow, the reviewer felt that the nomination should have been expanded in order to develop an area of significance for criterion "A". The reviewer stated that in order to nominate this property for all three criteria, an expanded discussion on Joe Mee's contribution to local ranching in Willcox would need to be developed. However, the reviewer also stated that "B" may be removed from the consideration by amending the area of significance to state only "Architecture".

The Arizona SHPO office is unable to develop an expanded discussion on Joe Mee's contribution to local ranching in Willcox. The nomination has been amended by deleting "B" from the form so that this property now is only nominated under criterion "C".
