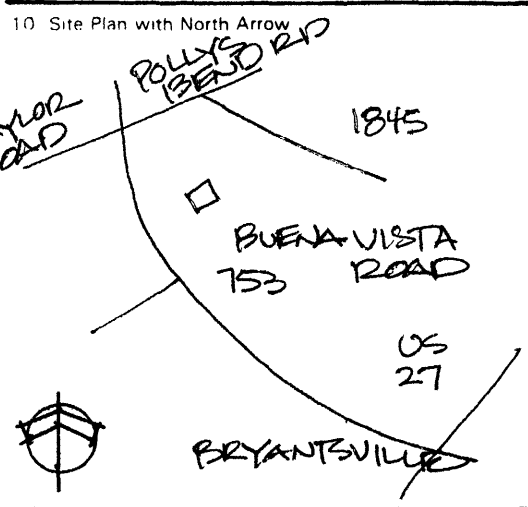

Perkins was first owner, then later sold to the Ruble family and then owned by Paul Wilson before being purchased by Hamiltons.

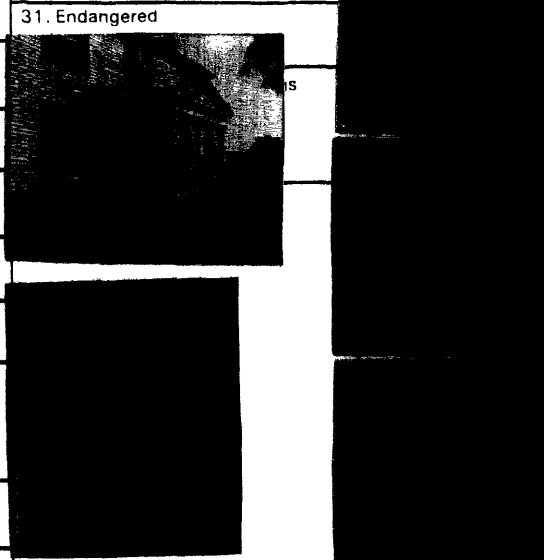

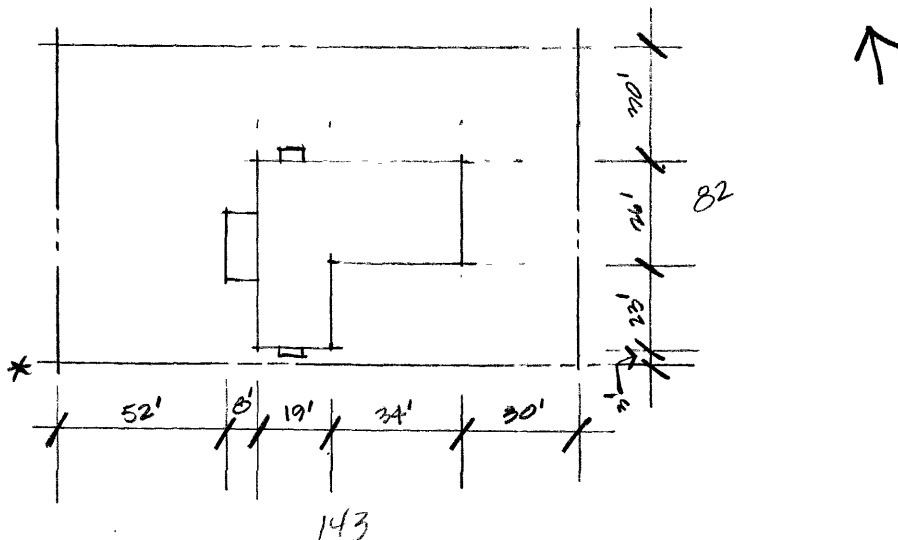

From a point in Polly's Bend Road, then East 82 feet to a point; then North 140 feet to a point; then West 82 feet to a point; then 140 feet South to the point of beginning.
The point of beginning is 52 feet west of the southwest corner of the Paul Wilson Place.
